

Evinos Reservoir



The man-made lake of Evinos was created by the construction of an earthen dam on Evinos River. The construction began in 1992 and was completed in the autumn of 2001. The surface area of the reservoir is 3.6 square kilometres and its watershed area is 352 square kilometres. Its maximum capacity is 138 million m³ of water, while its operational volume is 113 million m³. The project also included the construction of a tunnel (total length is 29.4 kilometres), which transfers Evinos' water to the Mornos reservoir.
